

Enquiries to the Housing Registrar from people seeking affordable housing

Thank you for your enquiry to the Housing Registrar about affordable housing.

We are the regulator of not-for-profit agencies providing community housing in Victoria. We do not own or manage any housing, run a waiting list, or allocate any housing.

We hope the information below is of assistance to you. However we encourage you to look at the special housing website created by the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) which includes lots of detailed, relevant information at www.housing.vic.gov.au

If you need urgent housing assistance

A Statewide telephone service 1800 825 955 is available 24 hours per day, 7 days per week to provide advice and link you to the service or HEF manager closest to you.

Affordable housing options

Affordable rental housing for people on lower incomes here in Victoria is provided by not-for-profit housing agencies as community housing, or directly through the state government as public housing. Some housing is long term, whilst some is short to medium term.

Most affordable rental housing is called social housing and has specified income and asset limits which apply to both community and public housing – refer <http://www.housing.vic.gov.au/social-housing-eligibility>

Some not-for-profit agencies have small numbers of other affordable housing with higher income limits than those for social housing. You may wish to enquire about these when applying for social housing via the process outlined below if you find your income is slightly above the specified social housing limits.

How do you know if you are eligible for social housing

In general, to be eligible for social housing you must live in Victoria and:

- have Australian citizenship or permanent residency status;
- not earn or own more than the current social housing income and asset limits;
- not be subject to Centrelink's two-year waiting period for newly-arrived migrants;
- not own or part-own a house, unit or flat; and
- provide the required proof of identity, residency status, and income and other documents.

Applying for social housing²

You can apply for all social housing (community and public housing) through the Victorian Housing Register (VHR).

The VHR has now replaced the public housing waiting list and different waiting lists maintained by not-for-profit agencies. You can find out more about the VHR and the application process at <http://www.housing.vic.gov.au/apply-social-housing>

There are three different ways to apply to the VHR:

- A support service you are already linked into or could approach, may assist – Support services can include Initial Application and Planning services, and homelessness services. You can ask any support worker you have, whether they are able to assist you to fill out an application form.

Alternatively you can call 1800 825 955 to seek help with applying.

There are two different categories of application for you to consider:

- *Register of Interest application* – needs to be completed by all applicants – helps to decide your general eligibility
- *Priority Access application* – is optional but helps to identify if you have a priority housing need

Who provides community housing

Not-for-profit agencies provide community housing in a range of places across Victoria. A list of agencies with contact details is attached.

Assistance available if you are renting in the private rental market

There are a range of different forms of assistance to assist you get into private market rental or to remain in the private rental market if you are experiencing hardship. You can read about these at:

Assistance includes:

- Bonds – DHHS operates a Bond Loan Scheme providing interest-free loans and some community organisations also provide bond loans through the Housing Establishment Fund (HEF)
- Paying rent – community housing tenants and private renters can be eligible for Commonwealth Rent Assistance to meet rent costs
- Concessions – various concessions are available for council rates, water, gas, electricity and cooling and utility relief
- Home renovations – loans are available to help people pay for work needed to their home
- Purchase of essential household equipment and appliances – interest free loans are available to assist in purchases of items such as fridges, washing machines, beds, televisions and clothes dryers.
